ANIMAL SCIENCE

This pathway is a four-year program designed for students who are interested in careers in agriculture and animal care. The pathway includes the study of plants and animals including animal anatomy, physiology, nutrition, reproduction, genetics, and health. All students in this pathway are enrolled in FFA, providing further business and leadership skills.

Level 2: Ag & Soil Chemistry (UC chemistry 'd' lab)

Level 3: Veterinary Science (UC 'd' lab, 'g' elective)
